## About SAFMAMS (1)


SAFMAMS aims to draw insights on the most useful forms of scientific advice for marine environmental management.

## About SAFMAMS (2)

One part of the project focus on identifying the most useful forms of advice for the RACs by reviewing relevant literature and interacting with stakeholders by means of interviews / workshops.

SAFMAMS partners are working with three RACs: The Pelagic RAC, the North Sea RAC and the Baltic RAC.
